- 1) High potential of infrastructure projects market
- 2) Opportunities to enter "long business"
- 3) Convenient geographical location
- 4) Qualified specialists

- 1) Investment climate
- 2) Imperfect legislation in field of PPP
- 3) Non-readiness of the society to accept private sector participation in infrastructure
- 4) Absence of positive examples of PPP projects implementation



What does Ukraine lack in the first place for the active start of PPP?

1) **Well structured** projects



2) Methodology of PPP projects preparation (from initiation to financial closing)



3) Specialists ready for PPP projects structuring (public authorities, mass media, civil society, expert environment)



Program of regional and urban development projects financial support in Ukraine (FSPRU)



Financial assistance to PPP projects structuring

*time of projects preparation – 2 years
financing on repayable basis
quality control*



Assistance to the institutional development of PPP market in regions

experience exchange (seminars, conferences, training visits of public authorities to the PPP projects sites in the Russian Federation);

trainings (trainings in Ukraine, participation in the programs of the PPP department of the Financial University of the Russian Federation);

assistance to establishment of regional PPP centers, preparation of model project documentation

Privileged loans from Vnesheconombank for the projects structured in the framework of FSPRU

Harmonization of methodology and legislation in field of PPP based on the best experience

Establishment of the PPP Centers Association with a headquarters in Astana, Kazakhstan



- 1) Creation of international groups of specialists on PPP issues for preparation and support of infrastructure projects
- 2) Implementation of pilot projects and their replication
- 3) Harmonization of the legislation and methodological approaches
- 4) Dissemination of successful experience, training of specialists in field of PPP
