Presentation of concession project on construction of motorway in Kiev

On November 1, 2012 the State Agency for investment and national projects of Ukraine has presented the project of construction of the Kiev city ring road as an element of National project "Air express". The feasibility study of the project was presented by J. Pimental, director of Zagope Construction and Engineering S.A., the approaches to the legal model of project implementations were presented by the representative of GLN.

The main characteristics of the ring road: 18 km of motorway including 700 m bridge and 6000 m overpass; the project cost – EUR 428 mln.; average speed of the road – 110 km/hour; number of lines – 2 at the main route and 3 – at the bridge in each direction; forecasted traffic intensity – 20 thousand vehicles per day in 2017 and up to 80 thousand vehicles per day in 2010; approximate fee at the concession part of the road – UAH 6 (EUR 0.58) for passenger cars and UAH 17-37 (EUR 1.66-3.55) for heavy vehicles.
